

CUT AWAY FOAMING CLEANER

TECHNICAL DATA SHEET

GENERAL INFORMATION

CUT-AWAY emulsifies problem soil and grease on hard surfaces. Its foaming power keeps soil suspended so it can be rinsed away. It is especially recommended for the removal of grease, oils, fats, soap scum and proteinaceous soils from floors, walls, and equipment in meat processing rooms. It is ideal for use in restaurants, institutional kitchens, food processing plants or any area where food may be prepared.

Authorized by the USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

Heavy Soil	10oz./gal.	1:13

DIRECTIONS

FOAM GUN APPLICATION

1. Cover or remove all food products from the area.
2. Remove excessive soil from surfaces manually or with a high pressure sprayer and hot water.
3. Fill applicator dispenser with CUT-AWAY.
4. Attach container to foam-generating nozzle.
5. Connect to normal pressure hot water hose.
6. Apply hot foam liberally to all washable hard surfaces.
7. Allow foam to stand for 5 minutes. Do not allow foam to dry.
8. Rinse with potable water using either a high pressure sprayer or hose nozzle.
9. Allow surfaces to drain dry. Do not wipe dry.
10. To sanitize surfaces, spray with Cello F-1000 SANITIZER following directions on label. Allow to air dry.

MANUAL OR MACHINE SCRUBBING

1. Dilute as recommended.
2. Apply with a clean mop, spray or simply wipe on with a sponge or cloth & allow to dwell 5 minutes.
3. Scrub the area with a floor machine or manually with a sponge or cloth.
4. Remove emulsified soil with a squeegee or wet/dry vacuum. (If foaming is excessive, use Cello DEFOAMER in the vacuum).
5. Rinse with a hot water spray.

SOAKING OPERATION

1. Dilute as recommended.
2. Immerse parts into the diluted cleaner.
3. For difficult-to-remove soil, the use of a brush or sponge may be necessary.
4. Rinse thoroughly with hot water & allow to air dry.

DANGER: Corrosive to eyes and skin. Contains caustic materials. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Rubber or plastic gloves should be worn when manual cleaning is being done. Rinse metal surfaces immediately. Product is an eye irritant and causes substantial eye injury. Wear protective glasses. Do not get into eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed.

FIRST AID: In the event of eye contact, flush eyes with large amounts of clear water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. In the event of skin contact, wash off with large amounts of water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. If swallowed, drink large amounts of water and contact physician.
